The Company ensures that all its activities are carried out in conformance with the relevant environmental legislation.

The activities are solely those of a non industrial environment so there are no significant emissions or effluents. The Company seeks to minimise energy consumption, waste and promotes recycling. The primary business activity is to promote sustainable events and a major part of this is to select and monitor contract services, of which great weight is given in the selection process to potential suppliers who themselves have sound environmental policies.

An essential feature of the environmental policy is a commitment to improving environmental performance. This is achieved by setting annual environmental improvement objectives and targets which are regularly monitored and reviewed as a part of the sustainable development management system. .

In our capacity as an Events venue provider and employer, we aim to:

- Ensure the effective management of resources thus reducing our impact on the natural environment
- Ensure effective selection of materials and working methods
- Foster employees' environmental awareness and concern, and integrate environmental management into training
- Encourage the participation of contractors, suppliers and clients in our environmental goals
- Improve our performance year-on-year
